



Pacific Northwest Cardiology is Now Skagit Valley Medical Center Cardiology

Effective January 1, 2009, Pacific Northwest Cardiology changed its name to Skagit Valley Medical Center Cardiology. This completes a one year transitional phase that allowed the Cardiology group to fully integrate into Skagit Valley Medical Center.

Pacific Northwest Cardiology was established in 1983 and joined Skagit Valley Medical Center in January 2008. This collaboration has allowed for the addition of new cardiovascular services, such as cardiac electrophysiology, in our community.

The new name will be one of only a few visible changes to the community. Patients will continue to find the same high quality cardiac care upon which PNWC built their reputation over the last twenty-five years. The majority of the transition to becoming fully integrated will be seamless from the public's perspective. However, patients seen in Anacortes will notice that the office location will move in January.

Skagit Valley Medical Center is a multi-specialty medical group that has served area residents since 1971. Today the medical staff has expanded to include more than ninety physicians and allied healthcare professionals caring for patients in Skagit and North Snohomish counties.
